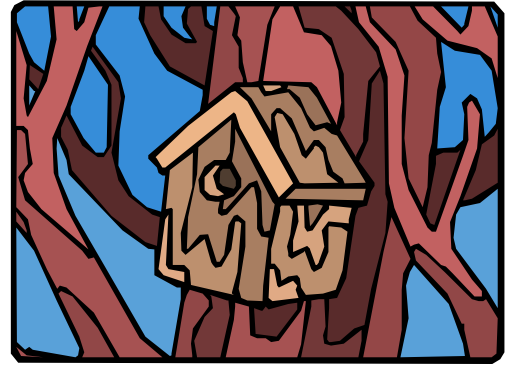


## Bird Houses

### Materials

½ gallon plastic or cardboard milk carton  
Scissors  
Bendable wire  
Wire cutters  
Ruler  
Nails  
Waterproof tape  
Dried grass  
Paper



### Directions

1. Rinse the carton well and completely open the top so that it is square.
2. Cut about a 1½" round hole on one side a couple inches below the top of the fold.
3. On the side opposite the hole, make two holes side-by-side using a nail. The holes should be about the same level as the other hole.
4. Cut a piece of wire about a foot long. Put it in through one of the holes, then out the other.
5. Put some dried grass in the carton.
6. Close the carton. Tape it shut.
7. Take it outside. Twist the wire ends to form a loop around a limb. Attach so the back of the house rests against the trunk for stability.
