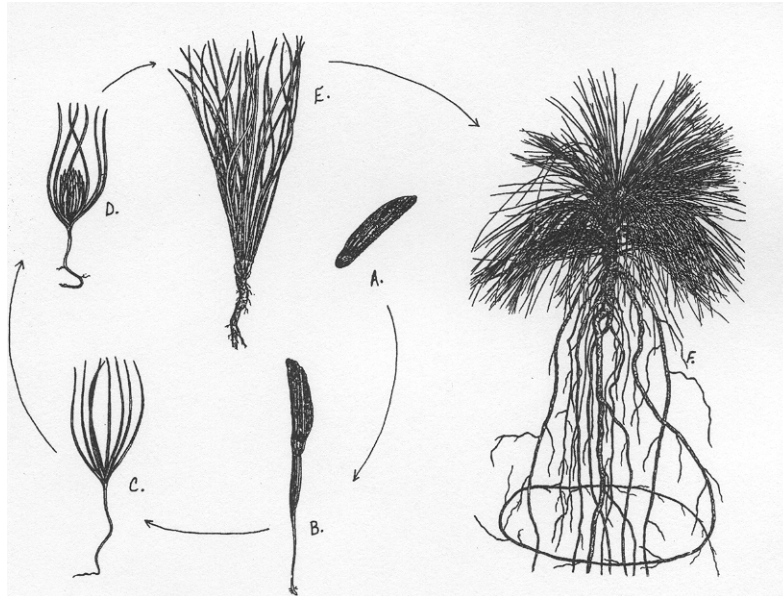


Longleaf Pine Stages

Label the stages of a longleaf pine.

| B. | 2. Young tree, about 3-4 years old, with developed roots |
| C. | 3. Seed falling |
| D. | 4. Seedling a few weeks older, shows clusters of primary leaves |
| E. | 5. Germinating seed |
| F. | 6. Seedling at the end of its first or second season, showing secondary leaves |
